We hope you and your child are enjoying accessing the home learning tasks. Learning will be set each Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

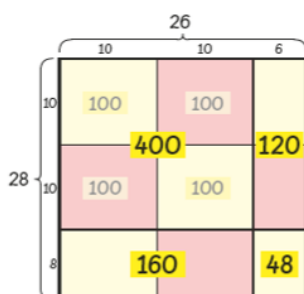
