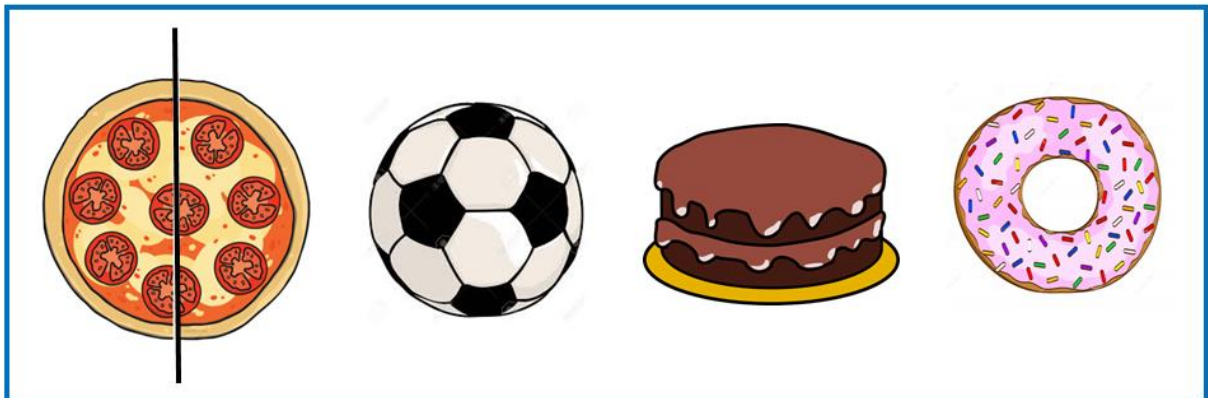
### Maths
