Home Learning Pack

Your child will have brought home a home learning pack in a zip wallet. This pack has the following things:

- school books to put their work in
- equipment (pencils, coloured pencils, ruler, glue stick)
- spelling and number resources
- a 'Home Learning sheet with a variety of learning activities

- ❖ You can send up to 3 pieces of learning school using the e-mail address for your year group or, if you prefer, you can drop it off at school if and when safe to do so.
- ❖ A member of staff will reply to your email and give feedback about your learning.
