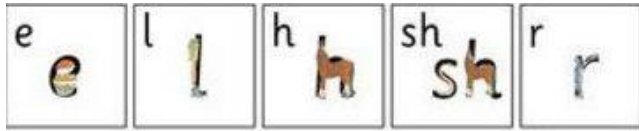


Read, Write Inc – Home Learning – Set 1 -4

Writing



The sounds we are revising this week are:

e, l, h, sh, r

Practise writing these letters as much as you can making sure that you form them correctly.

The handwriting rhymes we use to help us are:

e	Lift off the top and scoop out the egg.
l	Down the long leg.
h	Down the head to the hooves and over his back.
sh	(use s and h rhymes s- Slither down the snake. h - Down the head to the hooves and over his back.)
r	Down his back and then curl over his arm.

Reading

Practise your blending using some Fred Games!

Fred is a frog that can only say sounds. We have to help him blend the sounds into words!

Play Fred's fridge...



1. Fred went to the fridge and got some m-i-l-k. Ask children to repeat. Pause to allow children to 'jump-in' with the whole word. Can they work it out?
2. Repeat with e-gg-s, c-or-n, p-ea-s, h-a-m, j-a-m (stick to items with no more than 4 sounds)

Challenge

Words to practise reading. Get a grown up to write the words down. Have a go at reading them, pointing at each sound and blending the sounds together (Fred talking)

Fan, fun, fat, lip, log, let, had, hit, hen, ship, shop, fish
