With a grown up can you take it in turns to sing lines to a song or nursery rhyme?

Can you talk to someone and take it turns to listen and then talk?

### Physical Development

#### Traffic light game.

Green means move around, orange means freeze and red means stop.

When your grown up says a colour can you do different actions? Jump on the spot, run on the spot, star jumps and stretching up high.



## Playdough Recipe

You will need:

- 1 cup of salt
- 2 cups of plain flour
- 2 tablespoons of cream of tartar
- 2 tablespoons of cooking oil
- 2 cups of boiling water
- Food colouring
- Large bowl

Mix all the ingredients in a large bowl.

If you keep the dough in a plastic bag or airtight container, it will last for about six weeks.
