### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

#### **Number 8 –**

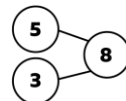
Can you make a number line from 0-10?

#### **Where is 8?-**

Using your number line, can you describe where the number 8 is? E.g. the number 8 is 1 more than 7 and/or 1 less than 9?

#### **Making 8-**

Can you draw a part whole diagram to show what two numbers added together make 8?

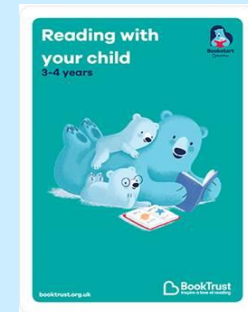
