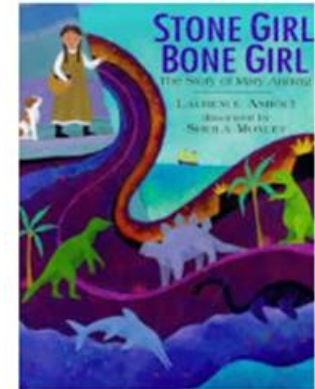
As readers we will be:
