Tourist - a person who is travelling or visiting a place for a holiday

Field work - practical work conducted by a researcher in the natural environment

Researcher – a person who wants to find things out about the world

Key question – the main question which leads a piece of field work

Ordnance survey map – a detailed map of a particular area

Key – a visual explanation of the symbols on a map

Symbols – pictures or icons which show things on a map

Data – information collected by a researcher

Graph – a way of presenting data collected by a researcher
